### Weekend of November 8-11, in Tulsa. Special guest from Houston.

Nick Cooper is a lifelong activist, musician, lecturer, film maker. He has a wealth of knowledge about successful nonviolent resistance movements such as the Zapatistas and others. He is well researched, well informed and coming to Tulsa to share his enthusiasm about the paradigm shift from co-optation to real freedom. The workshop includes theater exercises, readings and discussions. Connections are explored between the 2,500 year old Chinese text, the Tao Te Ching, and the modern writings of the Zapatistas. Participants compare their own experiences with historical examples of cooptation and institutionalization. After considering various non-hierarchical currents in history, including the Greek cynics, early Christianity, Quakers, Gandhi, Emma Goldman, and the Spanish civil war, the workshop concludes with a sociological exploration of Nazis, modern far right groups, and the military / industrial complex.

### Summary of TPF's Last Business Meeting (TPF Roundtable Discussion)

A. There was a *last minute* change of theme for this month's "first Saturday of the month" antiwar demo, in Tulsa, held Oct 6<sup>th</sup> The change of theme was okay'd via email on <a href="mailto:TPFSteeringCom@yahoogroups.com">TPFSteeringCom@yahoogroups.com</a>, our listserv for the Steering Committee (the Board). TPF responded to a **call-to-action** from United National Antiwar Coalition (UNAC) to make "US Out of Afghanistan" the theme for the weekend of Oct 5-7, in keeping with efforts in 20 other cities. The <a href="mailto:event notice">event notice</a> for TPF vigil was posted to TPF facebook discussion group, emailed to Ning subscribers, Yahoogroup subscribers, and Twitter subscribers.

For the next demonstration, TPF returns to the theme "**Ground the Drones**" and the demonstration will be held on Nov 3<sup>rd</sup> (see upcoming events listing, above)

Art/Music Festival at Chandler Park. Thousands are expected to attend the I AM Yoga,

Art + Music Festival scheduled for Sept. 14-15 at Chandler Park, 6500 W. 21 St., Tulsa.

"Yoga is a holistic experience," said festival co-creator and yoga instructor Melissa Joy. "It's not just a body experience. It's not just a workout. It's not just a mind experience, but it's for your spirit as well. It incorporates the whole person. There's not much else that does that."

The I AM Festival is a unique, family-friendly, yoga, art, and music festival, with free outdoor yoga classes -- from beginner to power classes -- offered throughout the weekend and coordinated with ongoing live music from the event's main stage.

Also on the schedule are many interactive opportunities such as belly dancing classes, community art projects, dance classes, a drumming class, and various children's programs. Organizers say that people attending I AM will be "forward thinking individuals who have an open mind and are receptive to organic, local, sustainable products and services."

The event is sponsored by Synergy Holistic Health. Among the vendors will be Henna tattoo artists, massage therapists, jewelry artists, yoga wear sellers, various local businesses, and natural health practitioners.
